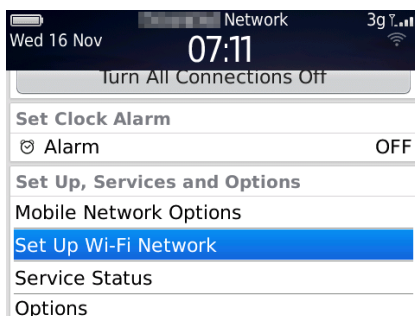


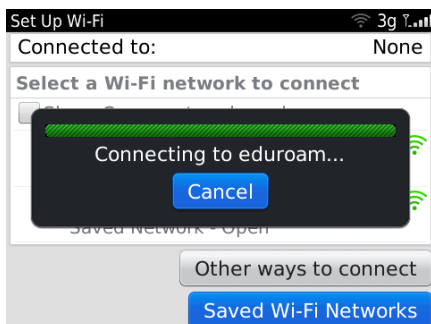
Connecting a Blackberry Device to the Wireless Network

These steps show how to connect a Blackberry device to the school's wireless network. This has been tested with Blackberry Version 6

1. Highlight the top bar (showing the date and time) on the Blackberry's main menu and then select it



2. Scroll down to 'Set Up Wi-Fi Network' and select the option
3. If asked, select 'Turn on Wi-Fi'
4. You are shown a list of detected networks, select "QM-BYOD"
5. New options appear. The Enterprise sub-type should be 'PEAP'
6. Enter your school network username and password for the User name and Password:
7. The Inner Link security is 'EAP-MS-CHAP V2'
8. Select 'Disable Server Certificate Validation'
9. Select 'Connect'
10. Your Blackberry should then attempt to connect to the school's wireless network



11. Your Blackberry will report 'Manually connecting to network was successful'. You are now connected and your settings are saved.

There are known issues with Blackberry Version 5 phones connecting; please upgrade your phone to the latest Blackberry Software Version before attempting to connect.

When you change your school network password, you will need to also change the password with which you are connecting to the wireless network with in step 6.
